FOREST ORDER

Being on a trail and road for public health and safety

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR Part 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the area described below and in attached Exhibit A – Location Area Map, on the Umpqua National Forest. This order is effective December 1st, 2012 until April 30th, 2013 unless sooner rescinded.

Motorized vehicles (snowmobiles) are prohibited on Hemlock Butte Ski Cabin Nordic Trail as described below:

- **Beginning at the junction of Forest Service Road 4795-300 (known as the Bailey Connect Trail and FS Road 4795-380 (known as the Hemlock Butte Ski Cabin Nordic Trail) to the Hemlock Butte Ski Cabin and continuing on to the Mt. Bailey Nordic Trail No. 1451. The Nordic trail is 1.5 miles in length and is located in T. 28 S., R. 5 E., section 22, 15, and 14, W.M.**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, State or local Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 2) Owners or lessees of land in the area.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
