OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited for the **National Forests in Alabama**. This closure order is effective from June 30, 2012 through June 30, 2017.

The following acts are **PROHIBITED** as set forth in 36 CFR 261.58:

Riding, hitching, tethering, or hobbling a horse or other saddle, or pack animal except upon roads open to vehicular traffic or those roads, trails, and/or areas, which are designated and signed open to equestrian use. **36 CFR 261.58 (aa)**


Riding, hitching, tethering or hobbling a horse or other saddle or pack animal in violation of posted instructions. **36 CFR 261.58 (aa)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) (f), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

Persons with a permit authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
