

RADEKE CABIN



This cabin was purchased by the Forest Service from the University of New Hampshire in 1969 and is located on the Kancamagus Highway, 14 miles from Conway, NH. Radeke Cabin is ideally located along the Kancamagus Scenic Byway with proximity to dozens of hiking trails, miles of ski trails, the Swift River, and beautiful mountain scenery and wildlife habitat. The cabin is rustic with limited amenities – there are ten wooden bunks divided into three rooms; a table, chairs, and a couch; and a woodstove – wood is provided. A pit toilet is located a short distance from the cabin. There is no potable water, running water or electricity.

Rental Fee: Radeke Cabin is \$40 per day, plus \$9.00 NRRS reservation fee.

Access: Route 112 (Kancamagus Hwy)

Capacity: 10 people

WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

Campers will need to bring those items typically associated with a camping trip.

- Sleeping bag, sleeping pad, etc.
- Matches, cooking equipment and cook stove
- Water. There is NO water, potable or otherwise, available at Radeke Cabin.
- Campfire wood from a local source (please see firewood note). Wood is provided for the indoor woodstove only.

Firewood Note: Our forests are threatened by non-native insects that can kill large numbers of trees. Three recently introduced insects are wood-infesting species that can be transported long distances in firewood. Once transported into new areas, these insects can become established and kill local trees. For this reason, firewood from outside the State of NH is prohibited. **Please use firewood from local sources.**

Pets: Pets are allowed on the National Forest and at the cabin. Please leash your pets on private land and ensure they are leashed or under voice control for the remainder of your trip.

HOUSEKEEPING:

- Please carry out all trash and excess food
- Please sweep the floor before you leave with the broom provided
- Please close and lock both doors, and windows when leaving

Note: The cabin is frequently rented and we may not be able to check cleanliness between visits. Please help us and other renters by leaving the cabin in as good of or better shape than you found it.

CAMPING RESTRICTIONS: No outside camping, which includes RV's, motor homes, etc. within one quarter mile of the cabin.

HOW DO I GET TO RADEKE CABIN?

From NH Route 16 in Conway take NH Route 112 (Kancamagus Highway) west for 14 miles, the cabin is on the right, one quarter mile before Passaconaway Campground. From Interstate route 93 in Lincoln take exit 32 for NH Route 112. At bottom of exit ramp, turn left (east) onto NH route 112. The cabin is approximately 20 miles on the left, one quarter mile after Passaconaway Campground.
