Type 1 Crews and Type 1 and 2 helicopters are required to support indirect firing operations. Lack of DIVS, TFLD and HEQB limit ability to staff expanding fire perimeter. Heavy dry fuels along with wind is pushing the fire to the south and east. Night fire behavior continues to be active.
