

2013 Permit Fee Billing Delayed

The mailing of the 2013 permit fee bills for Recreation Residences has been delayed. Our goal is to send those bills to you by December 1 of each year. Currently we are aiming to get the bills in the mail by January 2, 2013 and we will keep you updated if this scenario changes. All permit holders have 30 days to pay their bills once we send them out.

The delay is due to the issues associated with the transitioning of Forest Service financial accounting systems, and is not due to pending legislation. You can expect to be billed for the base permit fee amount listed in the letter we sent you in April of 2009, or given to you as part of the cabin sale process.
