



Order No. 17-12-05  
Motor Vehicle Restrictions  
USDA Forest Service  
Tahoe National Forest  
Yuba River Ranger District



Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety and protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the Yuba River Ranger District of the Tahoe National Forest. This Order is effective from December 13, 2012, through June 1, 2013.

1. Using any motor vehicle on the National Forest System roads listed below and shown on Exhibit A.
  - a. Forest Road No. 25 Eureka Road, from mile post 19.45 at Reese Ravine to mile post 22.80 on Morrystown Ridge.
  - b. Forest Road No.35 Cal Ida Scales Road, from mile post 8.56 at the intersection with the Forest Road No. 25-15 to mile post 17.11 to the end of Forest Road No. 35 on Morrystown Ridge.

36 CFR 261.54(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A. A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
