

Attention! Help protect your wildlife.

To protect nesting and roosting sites of golden eagles, the Glenclyff area is closed until July 1. This includes the area between Old U.S. Highway 80 and the ridgeline of Glenclyff, as shown on the map below.

How you can help protect golden eagles

Cliffs on the Cleveland National Forest provide critical breeding habitat for golden eagles. Human disturbance may cause eagles to abandon their nests and may result in offspring dying.
