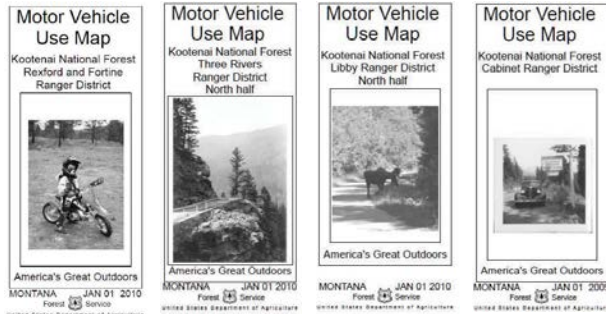


Get your MVUM (Motor Vehicle Use Map) FREE!



The Douglas Hill OHV Area contains approximately 9 miles of designated OHV trail, as well as approximately 200 acres designated OHV area both open to highway and non-highway legal vehicles.

In addition there is approximately 3600 acres of designated OHV area below high water mark on Lake Koocanusa (with exception of areas signed on ground for resource protection) open to highway and non-highway legal vehicles.



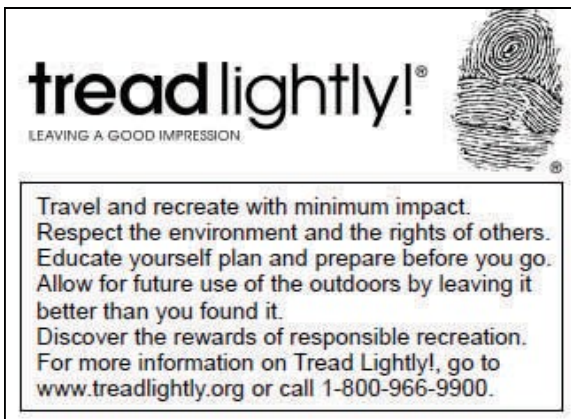
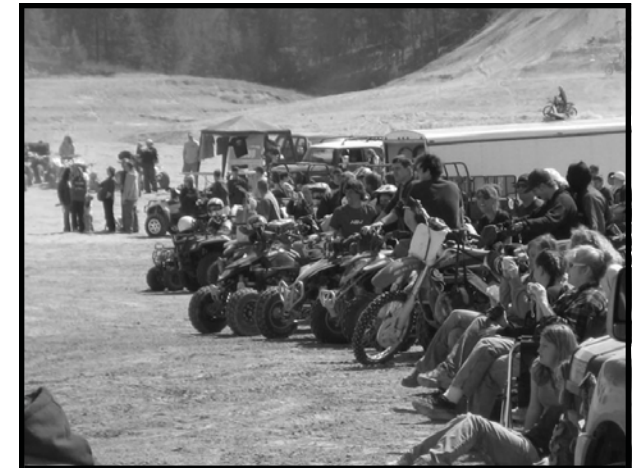
**Maintain spark

NO cross country travel is permitted on National Forest System Lands except in areas designated for cross country riding.

If riding on designated legal trails or in a designated area only and not traveling on any roads, the vehicle must have a Montana OHV registration decal. A vehicle title is required to acquire the OHV registration decal.

Beginning October 1, 2007, all motorcycles and OHV's ridden off-road must meet a 96 DBA (decibel) sound limit.
