

**EMERGENCY OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS
NATIONAL FOREST AREAS AND NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM TRAILS AND ROADS**

**DESCHUTES NATIONAL FOREST
SISTERS RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to 16 USC, 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited on areas and designated sections of National Forest system trails and roads as described below, and as shown on the attached map, within the Deschutes National Forest, hereby incorporated into this order as Attachment 'A'.

Beginning at a point located at the intersection of Forest Roads 1018 and 1520 in Township 15 South, Range 09 East, Section 20; thence east along Forest Road 1520 to its intersection with Forest Road 15 in section 26; thence north along Forest Road 15 to its intersection with the northern line of section 26; thence east along the northern line of section 26; thence south along the eastern line of sections 26 and 35; thence east along the northern line of section 2 in Township 16 South, Range 9 East; thence south along the eastern line of sections 2 and 11 to the intersection with Forest Road 16 near the 1514 junction; thence south along Forest Road 16 to the intersection of Forest Road 1600700 in Township 16 South, Range 9 East, Section 27; thence south along Forest Road 1600700 to its intersection with Forest Road 16 in Township 17 South, Range 9 East, Section 10; thence south along Forest Road 16 to the intersection of Forest Road 1600800; thence south along Forest Road 1600800 to the trailhead parking area; thence southwest on the Little Three Creek Lake Trail to its terminus at Little Three Creek Lake in Township 17 South, Range 09 East, Section 15; thence due west to the eastern line of section 16; thence north along the eastern line of section 16; thence west along the northern line of sections 16, 17 and 18; thence north along the eastern section line of section 12; thence west along the northern line of section 12; thence north along the eastern line of sections 2 and 35; thence west along the northern line of section 35; thence north along the eastern line of sections 27, 22, 15, 10, and 3 in Township 16 South, Range 08 East; thence west along the northern line of section 3 to its intersection with southeast corner of section 34; thence north along the eastern line of section 34 to its intersection with Trail #95 (Scott Pass); thence east along Trail #95 to its intersection with the Wilderness Boundary in section 36; thence north along the wilderness boundary to the northern line of section 24 in Township 15 South, Range 08 East; thence east along the northern line of sections 24, 19, and 20 where it intersects Forest Road 1018; thence south along Forest Road 1018 back to the point of beginning.

PROHIBITIONS

It is prohibited to go into or be upon any of the above described lands which are closed for the protection of public health and safety, including all National Forest System roads and trails therein. 36 CFR § 261.53(e)

Being on a forest system road. 36 CFR § 261.54(e)

These restrictions are in addition to those prohibitions enumerated in Subpart A of 36CFR§261 and any other special restrictions pertaining to the described lands.

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR§261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Personnel with written authorization by a Forest Officer, which specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act or omission. The issuing Officer may include such conditions as are considered necessary for the protection of the area, or for the promotion of the health, safety, or welfare of its users.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or volunteer in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons or their invitees who live or own property within the closure area, and permittees who have a legitimate need to access their permitted allotment if escorted or approved by IMT.
4. Forest Road 1018 south to the intersection of Forest Road 1520 shall remain open.
5. Forest Road 1520 shall remain open.
6. Forest Roads 16, 1600800, and 1600825 shall remain open.
7. Forest Road 1600700 (Three Creek Nordic Trail) and Jefferson View Winter Shelter shall remain open.
8. Three Creek Meadow/Horse Camp Campground shall remain open.
9. The trail leading from Three Creek Meadow Horse Camp southwest to Little Three Creek Lake shall remain open.

This closure is enacted due to firefighting activities taking place within the closure area, and for the protection of public and employee safety. This order replaces Order # 06-01-05-12-006, which is hereby rescinded. These prohibitions will remain in effect until rescinded.




Pole Creek Fire
