Pework Assignment

There are three components to the prework assignment.

1. Rent and view the DVD of *K-19: The Widowmaker* and answer the enclosed prework questions, which will be reviewed with you during the course. The assignment will take approximately six hours to complete, and you will be expected to turn in your prework on the first day of class. You can complete the prework assignment individually or in a group. This film is currently available in video stores. The instructors will reimburse you \$5.00 toward the cost of a rental.
2. Complete the enclosed self-assessment and bring it to class. This will be used to assist you with personal development exercises during the course; however sharing of this information will be optional.
3. **If you have not previously attended L-380 Fireline Leadership or Fire Service Leadership**, read the *Pre-Work Reference Guide* to familiarize yourself with the prerequisite concepts needed to complete the prework and the course.
