FIRE PROGRAM

The Bridgeport District Office is located in Bridgeport, California with an Interagency Fire Station in Topaz, California. The fire program consists of a Fire Management Officer, Assistant Fire Management Officer, Fire Operations Specialist, Fuels Officer, 2 Type 6 engines, 1 Type 4 Engine, 2 Fire Prevention Technicians and a Type III Interagency Helitack Crew. The district averages 30+ fires per year. The district works in an Interagency relationship with the following: Mono County, CA, Douglas, Lyon and Mineral Counties in Nevada, US Marine Corp Fire, Bishop and Carson City BLM, and the Inyo National Forest.

WORK CAPACITY TEST (WCT) for Wildland Firefighters: These positions participate in wildland firefighting activities. Based on the type of work performed, TAKING and PASSING the WCT at the ARDUOUS level is a "condition of employment." The Arduous fitness (Pack) test consists of a three (3) mile hike, within forty-five (45) minutes, while carrying a forty-five (45) pound pack. You are strongly encouraged to consult with your physician and begin training immediately if you are applying for these positions. This announcement constitutes the required 30 days advanced notice for testing requirements.
