Option One: Reduced Services



Current staffing, funding, and available partnership and volunteer resources are not sufficient to manage our developed recreation sites to a high standard. A reduction of services may be required to maintain the economic viability of the program and its components.

- Reduced trash, restroom, and campsite cleanup
- Reduced landscape maintenance
- Removal of some restroom facilities or picnic areas
- Removal of trash cans or fish cleaning stations
- Closure of water and wastewater systems (potable water, hot showers, flush toilets, dump stations)
- Closure of boat ramps
- Reduced Forest Service presence at developed recreation sites
- Reduction of capacity through the removal of camping loops or parking areas
- Reduction of access through seasonal closures or intermittent closures
