



AGATE CREEK TRAIL # 484 → 10.4 MILES ONE WAY

DIFFICULTY: Moderate

SEASON OF USE: June through October

ELEVATION GAIN: Trailhead is at 9,120', Continental Divide Trail intersection is at 11,840'.

USGS MAPS: Sargents, Pahlone Peak

ACCESS: This trail has two access points. Take Highway 50 east of Gunnison to locate the first trail access. Agate Creek trailhead is about four miles past the town of Sargents. Turn right into the trailhead and go to the far east end. An "Agate Creek Trail" sign marks the beginning of the trail. The second access to the trail is by going a few miles past the trailhead to a point on the road that is signed "Agate Creek". Pull off and park there. The trail descends down the creek on the Agate Spur #484 2A, which is 0.6 miles.

ATTRACTIONS: The Agate Creek Trail winds through the Agate Creek drainage paralleling the Continental Divide and eventually rising up to meet the Continental Divide Trail two and one half miles from Marshall Pass (see Crest Trail #531). Fishing is reported as fair along the creek.

CONSIDERATIONS: Always be prepared for adverse weather including rain, hail, thundershowers and lightning. Be sure to wear sunscreen and bring plenty of drinking water. Do not drink from mountain streams and lakes without treating it first. Be sure someone knows where you are going and when you plan to return.




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
