<b>Position Title:</b> Forestry Technician, Fire Lookout

<b>Duties:</b> The McCall Ranger District staffs 3 road-accessible lookouts that provide critical detection in the main Salmon River corridor, South Fork corridor and the western boundary of the Frank Church Wilderness, and areas adjacent to the Sesech and Warren communities. These lookouts coordinate detection coverage with lookouts on the Krassel Ranger District as well as lookouts on the Nez Perce-Clearwater NF. The Payette N.F. Fire Management Program relies heavily on Lookout positions to provide timely and accurate fire detection, fire size ups and monitoring information, weather observations, and critical all-hazard communications. Lookouts maintain records and logbooks, carry out routine facility maintenance, and maintain specialized lookout equipment. These positions are expected to serve as front line Forest ambassadors by providing a variety of educational and assistance information to numerous Forest users with very minimal oversight.
