**OCCUPANCY AND USE  
FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS**

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (a), for the health and safety of the public, and for the protection of resources, the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Craig Creek Recreation Area, (see attached map). This closure shall expire on June 30, 2017.

1. Camping. (36 CFR 261.58 (e))
2. Being in the area between the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM (designated day-use area). (36 CFR 261.58 (b)) (36 CFR 261.16 (e))
3. Using a motor vehicle on Forest Road 5058 beyond the gate at the designated camping area. (36 CFR 261.54 (a))


Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty.
2. Any person or group with a permit specifically authorizing the above activities.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of the above prohibition are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than (6) six months or both.
