OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (a), for the health and safety of the public, and for the protection of resources, the following act is prohibited at, or within 500 feet of the following locations: Appalachian Trail Partnership Shelter, Mount Rogers National Recreation Area Headquarters parking lot, Mount Rogers National Recreation Area administrative building and visitor center. These facilities are located within the Mount Rogers National Recreation Area, George Washington and Jefferson National Forest, Smyth County, Virginia

1. Possessing any beverage defined as an alcoholic beverage by State law.
36 CFR 261.58 (bb)

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.

This order will expire five (5) years after the date of execution.
