About the Position

Series/Grade: GS-0460-9

Title: Forester (Silviculture)

Location: Emmett, Cascade or Lowman, ID

Tour of Duty: Not to Exceed 120 days

Housing: No government quarters are available.

Duties: Participate in the preparation of financial and work plans for assigned programs by estimating, combining, and coordinating project plan into an annual unit work plan. Review work accomplishments for assigned areas of responsibility and compiles necessary reports.

Conducts examination of timber compartments and stand on the unit and evaluate the conditions found. Makes or recommends basic land management decisions based on these evaluations. Makes silviculture prescriptions and action plans for TSI and reforestation work necessary to attain timber management objectives using photography and on-the-ground observation and measurements.

Makes plantation and natural regeneration survival examination to determine that results meet accepted standards. Sets up check and inspections to determine the effectiveness of culture treatments. Makes recommendations to the supervisor on techniques, policies, and procedures to increase the effectiveness or improve the quality of treatments.

Prepares multiple-use compartment prescriptions and environmental assessment reports based on field examination and data.

Administers or supervises the administration of silvicultural contracts, including but not limited to TSI, reforestation, snowplowing, stand exam, and cone collection.

Expectations of the Detail:

Assists in the hiring of the GS-7 Forestry Technicians and/or the north zone silviculture temporary workforce.

Vegetation specialist with NEPA responsibilities for the Clear Creek Integrated Project. Oversight and mentoring will be provided.

Implementation of silvicultural contracts, especially the snow plowing and reforestation contracts. Preparation of the stand exam, cone collection, thinning and fall reforestation contracts.

Spatial delineation of the accomplishment layer for input into FACTS.

Stand delineation and re-delineation incorporating FS Veg.

Silvicultural prescriptions for prescribed fire projects.
