ABOUT THE POSITION:

The Arapaho and Roosevelt National Forests and Pawnee National Grassland is currently seeking applicants for three Range Technician or Range Aid, GS-0462-03/04/05 positions. The duty station for this position is located in Grand Lake, Colorado.

The incumbent will be responsible for the following duties:

The weed crew is primarily field oriented, but is expected to be responsible for a variety of duties over the course of employment. Duties include noxious weed treatment, inventory and monitoring: other duties may involve removing fences, working with partners or other resource projects. This work requires technical ability in plant identification and using herbicide application equipment. Training will be

provided. The work may be arduous due to rough terrain and adverse weather conditions. Employee must have a valid driver's license, be able to operate a standard transmission vehicle, and be able to hike up to five miles with a 25-30 lb pack.

Click on the **Position Title** link and an **Apply Online** button will become available for creating a profile and applying to the job. Be sure to select Grand Lake, Co as the duty station.
