## **Wilderness/Trails – Required work Period May 6 - Sept. 30, 2013**

\*\*The position listed below will be working on hazard tree removal along trails. The work will include falling, bucking, limbing, and removal of lodgepole pine trees affected by the mountain pine beetle epidemic. Additional work will include trail maintenance, reconstruction, rehabilitation along the trails and working with volunteers. Skills required for GS-5 positions include, but not limited to chainsaw and cross cut saw experience and/or the ability to be a certified feller, the ability to be a crew leader and trail maintenance experience.\*\*
