About The Position

This position is established at the Forest Supervisors' Office in South Lake Tahoe, CA. The incumbent has primary responsibility for the planning, implementation, and administration of the vegetation/timber management program.

This position includes establishing program goals, setting priorities and laying out work schedules. Develops annual program of work, prepares project work plans, and develops long-and short-term budget needs. Documents work progress and accountability of the timber program activity. Included in this program are the timber sale preparation, timber sale administration, planning, permitting and contracting.

Coordinates among other program and staff areas including transportation, silviculture, soil & water, weeds, botany, wildlife, and other local and regional specialists. Is accountable for appraisal packets and preparation of timber sale contracts. Reviews logging plans with operator to ensure understanding of contract requirements. Inspects logging operations to ensure fulfillment of silvicultural objectives, protection of watershed, esthetic, and wildlife values, and that contract stipulations are observed.
