Major duties include: Timber sale preparation by marking trees for harvesting, marking sale area boundaries and aiding cruiser with basic tree measurements. Other duties include: conducting regeneration surveys, common stand exam and insect and diseases surveys. Housing is not available. Camping may be required in remote areas. Field per diem of \$22/day is authorized of camping.

Information Receptionist:

Duties include providing visitor information and the sale of merchandise at the Grand Mesa Visitor Center. The GMVC is open from 9 to 5, 7 days/week from Memorial Day weekend through Color Sunday (late Sept). Duty station is at the Visitor Center located atop the Grand Mesa National Forest. Housing may be available at the Ward Lake Ranger Station. Work schedule varies but likely includes some weekend and holiday work.

Trail Crews:

Trail crew members are split into various crews (shown below). The OHV crew performs trail maintenance, signage and visitor contacts during a Friday through Monday (4/10's) schedule. While most other crews work Mon-Thursday (4/10's), some weekend/holiday work may be required. Trail crew members required to stay out throughout the work week in tent camps, camp trailers and/or work stations (depending on project location).

Major duties of the Grand Valley Ranger District Fuels Crew include fuels reduction work such as thinning the woods with a chainsaw, feeding the slash into a brush chipper, and/or piling the slash to be burned later. The crew lays out boundaries (flags and GPS's) for contract mechanical work. The crew collects and measures fuel moisture samples. The crew performs various other duties in support of the District's needs.

The crew assists the BLM Fire Fighters in local Initial Attack fire suppression. Crew members may also be involved with off-unit fire assignments lasting up to 2 weeks.

All necessary training will be provided by the agency.


