2013 Silviculture Crew Outreach

Positions: We are planning to fill two to four positions on the silviculture crew in 2013. These positions are being filled through an on-line application process. Interested individuals are encouraged to apply for any and all positions for which they feel they are qualified.

Work Schedule: Employment is expected to last from early May through September (dates may be negotiable). The normal work schedule is Monday-Thursday, 10-hours per day; however, certain assignments routinely require overnight camping of up to 1-week and will result in overtime pay. Shared housing in Fort Collins may be available and costs are approximately \$4.85 per day.

Salary/Benefits: Earn \$12.82-16.10 per hour. Employees will earn 4 hours of sick leave and 4 hours of annual leave every two weeks. Per diem is paid during travel. Employees will be compensated for federal holidays that fall during regularly scheduled work days.

Duties: The silviculture crew is primarily field oriented, but is expected to be responsible for a variety of duties over the course the season. Duties include stand examination, reconnaissance, boundary layout, tree cutting and piling, and contract inspection. This work requires technical ability in tree and plant identification, mensuration and the ability to work around pesticides. Some training will be provided. Successful applicants must be prepared for strenuous hiking of up to 6-miles per day through rough terrain while carrying a 30-lb pack and working in adverse weather conditions. Employees must also have a valid and unrestricted driver's license and be able to operate a standard transmission vehicle.
