

Notice of Decision  
Fremont-Winema National Forest Programmatic Restoration Project

On December 28, 2012 Fred Way, Forest Supervisor for the Fremont-Winema National Forests, signed the Decision Notice to implement the Fremont-Winema National Forest Programmatic Restoration Project. The decision covers future restoration and resource improvement actions located across the Forest.

The decision will allow the Forest to play an active role in the development and implementation of desired watershed restoration and resource improvement actions through a collaborative effort with local agencies, the Klamath Tribes, and various organizations. This decision is not subject to appeal and may be implemented immediately. The NEPA analysis was prepared in accordance to Council of Environmental Quality (CEQ) regulations 40 CFR 1500.5(h) and 40 CFR 1506.3(b) which did not require the Forest to recirculate the USFWS EA for Programmatic Restoration in the Upper Klamath Basin for comment which meant that there was no way to establish standing for appealing the decision. The Forest provided for public comment prior to signing the decision and adjusted the programmatic restoration decision based on the comments received.
