**Trail Work Day Announcement**  
**Chattooga and Chauga “River Sweep”**

**Project** — Picking up litter at various river access locations along the Chauga River and the Chattooga River on the Sumter National Forest.

**When** — Saturday, March 2, 2013, 8:00 am until noon.

**Where to Meet** —US Forest Service Stumphouse Ranger Station (our office) on Highway 28, five miles north of Walhalla.

**What to Wear** — Check the weather forecast the day before, remember it is frequently cooler and rain is more likely to occur in this area than in the piedmont. Dress accordingly. Wear good walking shoes and layer your clothing.

**What to Bring** — Transportation to and from the work areas, work gloves, drinking water, a daypack, and any medications you may need. We will supply the trash bags.

**LUNCH WILL BE PROVIDED** after trash collection at Chattooga Sounds on Damascus Church Road, Long Creek!!!

**You must sign up in advance!!!!**

**Volunteer Agreement** — You will need to sign a volunteer agreement Saturday morning.

**Youth under 18 years of Age**- Youth under 18 years of age must bring a parent or other parent-designated adult over 18 yrs. old to work with on the project. If there is a group of youth under age 18, one adult supervisor per five youth is required.
