The **White Mountain National Forest** is seeking qualified applicants to fill a variety of temporary full-time positions for the 2013 summer season which typically runs from Mid-May through the end of September. The **deadline to apply to these positions is March 4, 2013**. Please be advised that these are temporary summer seasonal positions that may be subject to change and/or early release depending on funding. POSITIONS AVAILABLE:

Visitor Information Services Assistant – staffs a visitor center providing Forest information and education. Sells forest products permits and retail items. Helps deliver interpretive and educational programs to a variety of audiences.

Developed Recreation Technician – performs a variety of maintenance tasks at recreation sites and day use areas including cleaning toilets, trash removal, mowing lawns, collecting and processing recreation fees and enforcing Forest regulations.

Backcountry/Wilderness Ranger – performs visitor information and education, maintains sites and facilities, and enforces Forest regulations at remote sites in backcountry and Wilderness areas.

Trail Crew Member and Leader – performs trail maintenance and reconstruction. Work includes cleaning waterbars, clearing blowdowns, brushing, and blazing. Heavy reconstruction work involves quarrying and setting rocks and logs for waterbars, staircases, turnpikes, and other trail features.

Forestry Technician (Timber Stand Improvement and Timber Sale Prep) – performs brushsaw/chainsaw removal of non-commercial trees, collects seedling and tree data, layout and painting skid trails and timber sale boundaries, tallying and marking timber for harvest and other duties. Duties could include site preparation for prescribed fire operations.

YCC Crew Leader – recruits, trains, and supervises a six person group of 15-18 year old youths in a variety of natural resource projects and educational activities.

Equipment Operator and Laborer – work performed on the Construction & Maintenance Crew as an equipment operator (CDL required) or laborer on road projects across the Forest. Both positions will be physically located in Bartlett, NH, but you will need to select Campton, NH as the duty location.

Archaeologist - conduct field surveys for historical and archaeologist resources in support of ongoing projects.

Botanist - conduct field surveys for rare plants in support of ongoing projects.

Survey Technician - assist in road, landline and resource surveys.

Biological Technician (Wildlife) - conduct field surveys of wildlife, birds, fisheries and treat invasive plants.
