

Special Road Restrictions and Road Closure Order
For National Forest System Road (NFSR) 300 (Four Mile Road), NFSR 300.4K (Well # 5 Road), NFSR 300.4M (Old Mid Thompson Park) NFSR 321 (Twin Peaks Road), and NFSR 321.1B (Well #9 Road),
During Commercial Operations Associated With the Sunshine Timber Sale, North Thompson Timber Sale and SourceGas, LLC Building Replacement Projects
Sopris Ranger District
White River National Forest
Garfield County, Colorado and Pitkin County, Colorado

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the described National Forest System Roads (NFSR) located within the Sopris Ranger District, White River National Forest, Garfield County, Colorado and Pitkin County, Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the Restricted Roads. The Restricted Roads are also depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A. This Order shall be in effect beginning upon the date of the signing of this order and continue until rescinded or until May 20, 2013 whichever event occurs first. Refer to the White River National Forest Winter Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) for additional winter use information and restrictions in the area.

The purpose of this Order is to protect public health and safety during commercial logging operations (including but not limited to project access, log haul, tree cutting, decking and loading trucks on roads, snowplowing and other road maintenance activities) and natural gas operations (including but not limited to project access, snowplowing and other road maintenance activities) associated with building replacement activities at Well #5 and Well #71.

The Restricted Roads are further defined as follows:

1. National Forest System Road 300 –From the intersection with the Upper Trailhead Parking Lot (NE¼ of Section 31, T7S, R89W) or approx. 2.8 miles from the intersection with Garfield County Road 117 to the road closure gate located in Four Mile Park (NE¼ of Section 1, T8S, R90W).
2. National Forest System Road 300 –From the road closure gate located in Four Mile Park (NE¼ of Section 1, T8S, R90W) to the intersection with NFSR 321 (SE¼ of Section 35, T8S, R90W).
3. National Forest System Road 300.4M - From the intersection of NFSR 300 (SW¼ of Section 35, T8S, R90W) east to the termination of NFSR 300.4M at the abandoned well pad #31 (SE¼ of Section 31, T8S, R89W).
4. National Forest System Road 300.4K - From the intersection of NFSR 300 (SE¼ of Section 35, T8S, R90W) southeast for approximately 0.6 miles (Sunshine Timber Sale Area Boundary) (N½ of Section 2, T9S, R90W).
5. National Forest System Road 321 - From the beginning of NFSR 321 (SE¼ of Section 35, T8S, R90W) east to the termination of NFSR 321 at Wolf Creek Well Pad #5 (NE ¼ of Section 1, T9S, R90W).
6. National Forest System Road 321.1B - From the intersection of NFSR 321 and NFSR 321.1B (SW¼ of Section 36, T8S, R90W) north to the termination of NFSR 321.1B at pad #14 (SW ¼ of Section 36, T8S, R90W).

PROHIBITION:


1. Being on the road (36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e))

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:


1. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a Forest Service contract or permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
