

ROAD MAINTENANCE LEVELS

ROAD MAINTENANCE LEVELS DEFINE THE LEVEL OF SERVICE FOR AND THE MAINTENANCE REQUIRED FOR EACH ROAD. THE ROADS THAT FALL UNDER ANY MAINTENANCE LEVEL CAN VARY WIDELY AS IS EVIDENT FROM THE PHOTOGRAPHS BELOW.

MAINTENANCE LEVEL 5 ROADS



120 MILES OF MAINTENANCE LEVEL 5 ROADS ON THE NANTAHALA AND PISGAH NATIONAL FORESTS.
AVERAGE ANNUAL MAINTENANCE COST PER MILE = \$14,600

MAINTENANCE LEVEL 4 ROADS



177 MILES OF MAINTENANCE LEVEL 4 ROADS ON THE NANTAHALA AND PISGAH NATIONAL FORESTS.
AVERAGE ANNUAL MAINTENANCE COST PER MILE = \$9,600

MAINTENANCE LEVEL 3 ROADS



505 MILES OF MAINTENANCE LEVEL 3 ROADS ON THE NANTAHALA AND PISGAH NATIONAL FORESTS.
AVERAGE ANNUAL MAINTENANCE COST PER MILE = \$5,700

MAINTENANCE LEVEL 2 ROADS



973 MILES OF MAINTENANCE LEVEL 2 ROADS ON THE NANTAHALA AND PISGAH NATIONAL FORESTS.
AVERAGE ANNUAL MAINTENANCE COST PER MILE = \$1,400

MAINTENANCE LEVEL 1 ROADS



521 MILES OF MAINTENANCE LEVEL 1 ROADS ON THE NANTAHALA AND PISGAH NATIONAL FORESTS.
AVERAGE ANNUAL MAINTENANCE COST PER MILE = \$425
