About the Position

Series/Grade: GS-0462-8/9 or GS-0401-09

Title: Forestry technician (Fuels)/ District Fuels Specialist

Location Lowman, ID

Tour of Duty: Not to Exceed 120 days

Housing: Government quarters may be available.

Performs work in fuels management, wildland fire prevention (pre-suppression) and suppression. Assists in planning, implementing and coordinating all aspects of the prescribed fire and fuels management program. Provides assistance in program direction, short and long range planning and budget of the fuels management and prescribed fire programs Plans and conducts project assessments which determine the presence or absence of hazardous wildland fuels. Information on fuel conditions and predictions of fire behavior are collected through a variety of methods, including field surveys, computer modeling, and specific literature searches.. Evaluates prescription treatments, monitoring methods and new technologies and makes refinements as appropriate. Provides input to the natural resources management program by gathering, compiling, and analyzing data to determine needs. Individually or through participation on interdisciplinary teams, studies and plans proposed resource management activities, and coordinates and/or implements approved resource management plans such as habitat restoration or enhancement. Results are used in the determination and prioritization of prescribed fire and mechanical treatment projects Uses input from the interdisciplinary team, annual objectives, and management direction to develop and recommend schedule of treatment.

Reviews project plans and makes recommendation on appropriate levels of monitoring. Participates in wildland fire and safety training in the techniques, practices, and methods of fire suppression and in the safe, efficient operation and use of tools, equipment, and vehicles used in fire suppression activities, with emphasis on those used for the particular function assigned. Participates in preparedness reviews, proficiency checks and drills, safety sessions, and after action reviews. Supports wildland fire suppression activities. Duties listed are at the full performance level.

This position has been identified under the Forest Service Fire Program Management (FS-FPM) and is subject to selective placement factor requirements contained in the Forest Service Fire Program Management (FS-FPM) Standard and Guide when filling this vacancy.

Expectations of the Detail:
