**JUAN TABO AND LA CUEVA OCCUPANCY AND USE
CLOSED AFTER SUNSET AND BEFORE SUNRISE**

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following act is prohibited within the area described in this Order and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the "restricted area") within the Sandia Ranger District, Cibola National Forest, Bernalillo and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico.

1. Being in the restricted area after sundown or before sunrise. 36 CFR 261.58(1).

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED

The restricted areas are described as follows:

1. The Juan Tabo Picnic Area excluding Forest Road 333A located in T.12N., R.4E, Section 35, NMPM, Sandoval County, New Mexico. T.11N., R.4E, Section 2, NMPM, Bernalillo County, New Mexico.
2. The La Cueva Picnic Ground, access road 333B, and all associated parking areas located in T.11N., R.4E., Sections 2, 10, and 11, NMPM, Bernalillo county, New Mexico.

These areas are shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.


PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect resources and to provide for public health and safety.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until December 31, 2013 or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581]
3. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by the Order.
