

**NATIONAL FOREST TIMBER FOR SALE

Due to previously unknown information, the Plumas National Forest has decided to rescind the Ohio Roadside Hazard Tree Fire Salvage Sale as formerly advertised on 03/13/2013, and re-advertise the Sale as written below. Please note the CHANGE IN THE BID DATE. More information regarding additional changes to the Ohio Roadside Hazard Tree Fire Salvage Sale and revised sale documents are available to the public from the MT. The Ohio Roadside Hazard Tree Fire Salvage Sale is located within Sections 1, 13, 23, & 24 of T26N, R7E; Sections 5, 6, 7, 17, 18, & 20 of T26N R8E; and Sections 29 & 32 of T27N R8E; MDM. The Forest Service will receive sealed bids in public at QUINCY, CA at 10:00 AM local time on 04/11/2013 for an estimated volume of 816.3 MBF of Douglas Fir sawtimber, 143.8 MBF of Incense Cedar sawtimber, 273.9 MBF of Ponderosa Pine sawtimber, 173.9 MBF of Sugar Pine sawtimber, and 573.4 MBF of White Fir sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, there is within the sale area an unestimated volume of Combined Softwood cull logs that the bidder may agree to remove at a fixed rate. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Interested parties may obtain a prospectus from the office listed below. A prospectus, bid form, and complete information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale, and submission of bids is available to the public from the MT.
