

ORDER NO. 02-13-02
CLEVELAND NATIONAL FOREST
ALCOHOL PROHIBITION

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the Palomar Ranger District of the Cleveland National Forest. This Order is effective from April 5, 2013, through April 4, 2016.


Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage under California state law within the Cedar Creek Falls Alcohol Prohibition Area. The Cedar Creek Falls Alcohol Prohibition Area includes all National Forest System lands within ¼ mile of Cedar Creek Falls, ¼ mile to the north and ¼ mile to the south of the San Diego River Gorge Trail and Trailhead, and ¼ mile on either side of the Eagle Peak Road Trail and Trailhead, as shown on Exhibit A.

36 CFR § 261.58 (bb).

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
