

**RESTRICTED USE
MOKELUMNE WILDERNESS AREA**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety and protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the Mokelumne Wilderness Area, the Round Top Special Interest Area, and the Salt Springs Reservoir Area. This Order is effective from May 1, 2013 through June, 2015.

1. Camping within the Mokelumne Wilderness Area, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.58(e).
2. Entering or being in the Mokelumne Wilderness Area as part of a group that includes more than 12 persons, as shown in Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.58(f).
3. Building, maintaining, attending or using any fire above 8,000 feet within the Mokelumne Wilderness Area, as shown in Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.52(a).
4. Building, maintaining, attending or using any fire ¼ mile above 3949 feet (high water line) on the north and east sides of the Salt Springs Reservoir, as shown on Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.52(a).
5. Grazing a horse or other saddle or pack animal within the Round Top Special Interest Area, as shown on Exhibit A 36 CFR 261.57(e).
6. Riding or allowing a horse or other saddle or pack animal off National Forest System trails within the Round Top Special Interest Area, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.58(aa).
7. Possessing more than 12 horses or other saddle or pack animals per group within the Mokelumne Wilderness Area, as shown in Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.58(s).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. Persons with a valid Campfire Permit are not exempt from the prohibitions listed above. However, persons with a valid Wilderness Permit may use portable stoves or lanterns that use gas, jellied petroleum, solid fuel tablets, or pressurized liquid fuel within the Mokelumne Wilderness Area and the Salt Springs Reservoir Area.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
