

Directions to Tusayan RD Free Use Fuelwood Cutting Areas

There are seven (7) areas located on the Tusayan Ranger District for gathering free fuelwood. All units are signed and unit boundaries are painted with orange paint. Directions provided below are from either the Tusayan Ranger Station or the Cameron field office:

1. **Unit A-1:**

Species: Pinyon, Ponderosa, Juniper **Cut:** Spring 2010/Spring 2011

Vehicles: High clearance recommended (rocky, rutted)

Directions from Tusayan Ranger Station:

1. Drive S on Hwy 64 to Long Jim Loop Rd (just past Best Western) – *1.3 miles*
2. Turn right (W) on Long Jim Loop Rd to FR 2607 turnoff – *0.3 miles*
3. Turn left (S) and then take immediate right (W) onto FR 2607 (unsigned) to cutting area – *0.5 miles*
4. Cutting area is located on left (S) side of FR 2607 just past junction with FR 2607B (signed).
5. Wood is available sporadically in the southeastern portion of the unit but is available immediately adjacent to FR 2607, 2617, and 2604 in the northwestern portion of the unit.

2. **Unit A-2:**

Species: Pinyon, Ponderosa, Juniper **Cut:** Spring 2010

Vehicles: High clearance recommended (rocky, rutted)

Directions from Tusayan Ranger Station:

1. Drive S on Hwy 64 to FR 306 (turnoff signed along highway) – *4.1 miles*
2. Turn right (W) on FR 306 to FR 306J (signed) – *1.6 miles*
3. Take right fork (FR 306J) to FR 9118HC (signed) – *0.6 miles*
4. Take right fork (FR 9118HC) to FR 335 (signed) – *0.1 miles*
5. Take right fork (FR 335) to FR 2607 (signed) – *0.7 miles*
6. Take right fork (FR 2607) to cutting area – *1.8 miles*
7. Cutting area is located on right (E) side of FR 2607 just past “Firewood Cutting Area” sign.
8. Wood is available immediately adjacent to FR 2607 throughout the unit.

3. **Unit B-1:**

Species: Pinyon, Ponderosa, Juniper **Cut:** 2009

Vehicles: Low clearance OK, but high clearance recommended (rutted)

Directions from Tusayan Ranger Station:

1. Drive S on Hwy 64 to FR 308 (signed) – *6.5 miles*
2. Turn right (W) on FR 308 to cutting area – *0.0 miles*
3. Cutting area is located on right (E) side of FR 308 just past “Firewood Cutting Area” sign.
4. Wood is generally available >100 feet from FR 308 in the S end of the unit and immediately adjacent to FR 308 in the N end of the unit.

4. **Unit S-1:**
Species: Ponderosa *Cut:* Fall 2010/Spring 2012
Vehicles: Low clearance OK

Directions from Tusayan Ranger Station:

1. Drive S on Hwy 64 to FR 302 (just past “The Grand Hotel”) – *1.3 miles*
2. Turn left (E) on FR 302 to FR 310 (signed) – *13.9 miles*
3. Turn left (N) on FR 310 to FR 2719 (signed) – *1.2 miles*
4. Turn left (W) on FR 2719 to cutting area – *0.9 miles*
5. Cutting area is located on both sides of FR 2719 just past “Firewood Cutting Area” sign.
6. Most of the available wood is located past the point where FR 2719 makes a sharp right near “Road Closed” sign. An abundance of wood from 2010 cutting is available in west end of unit (accessed by turning left to stay on FR 2719 ~0.3 miles past “Road Closed” sign).

5. **Unit S-2:**
Species: Ponderosa *Cut:* Spring 2012
Vehicles: Low clearance OK

Directions from Tusayan Ranger Station:

1. Drive S on Hwy 64 to FR 302 (just past “The Grand Hotel”) – *1.3 miles*
2. Turn left (E) on FR 302 to FR 310 (signed) – *13.9 miles*
3. Turn left (N) on FR 310 to cutting area – *0.3 miles*
4. Cutting area is located on left (S) side of FR 310 in the vicinity of the “Firewood Cutting Area” sign.
5. Wood is available immediately adjacent to FR 310.

6. **Unit S-3:**
Species: Ponderosa *Cut:* Spring 2012
Vehicles: Low clearance OK

Directions from Tusayan Ranger Station:

1. Drive S on Hwy 64 to FR 302 (just past “The Grand Hotel”) – *1.3 miles*
2. Turn left (E) on FR 302 to FR 310 (signed) – *13.9 miles*
3. Turn right (E) on FR 310 to cutting area – *1.0 miles*
4. Cutting area is located on right (S) side of FR 310 just past “Firewood Cutting Area” sign.
5. Wood is available immediately adjacent to FR 310.

7. **Unit U-1:**
Species: Pinyon, Juniper *Cut:* Fall 2011
Vehicles: High clearance recommended (rocky)

Directions from Cameron field office:

1. Drive S on Hwy 89 to Hwy 64 – *1.1 miles*
2. Turn right (W) on Hwy 64 to “Kaibab National Forest” sign – *19.2 miles*
3. Continue past “Kaibab National Forest” sign to FR 682 (just before MP 270) – *6.4 miles*
4. Turn left (W) on FR 682 to 2-track road – *1.0 miles*
5. Turn left (S) on 2-track road to cutting area – *0.2 miles*
6. Cutting area is located on right (W) side of 2-track road just past “Firewood Cutting Area” sign.
