INTEGRATED RESOURCE TIMBER CONTRACT - STEWARDSHIP

UMPQUA NATIONAL FOREST

The Oak Flats Stew Integrated Resource Timber Contract is located within T.26S., R.2E., Sections 24, 25 and 36; T.26S., R.3E., Sections 30 and 31, W. M., Unsurveyed, Douglas County, Oregon. The Forest Service will receive technical and price proposals (no public opening) at the Umpqua National Forest Headquarters, 2900 N.W. Stewart Parkway, Roseburg, Oregon 97471 no later than 1:00 PM local time on or before June 3, 2013 for an estimated volume of 9,925 TON of Douglas-fir and Other Coniferous Species Sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, the contract area contains an unestimated volume of biomass material that the bidder may agree to remove at a fixed rate. Also included in the contract are seven (7) mandatory restoration service projects to be completed by the Contractor. The contract will be awarded based on a Best Value determination. One award will be made to the Bidder, (a) whose proposal is technically acceptable, and (b) whose technical/price relationship is the most advantageous to the Government. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all technical and price proposals. Interested parties may obtain a prospectus from the office listed below. A prospectus, bid form, and complete information concerning the timber, the restoration projects, the conditions of the contract, and submission of bids is available to the public from the Umpqua National Forest, 2900 N.W.
