**Assessment of Need and Enforcement Plan**

**Background:**

Forest Road 32 along the Umatilla River was washed out and damaged in the flooding that occurred in late April of 2013. The road is closed to motor vehicles for the safety of the general public.

**Intent of Subpart B Order:**


The order is needed to protect the general public until such time that the road can be repaired and made safe for motor vehicle use.

**Enforcement Plan:**

Enforcement of this order will be performed by LEOs, FPOs and Special Agents. It will be at their discretion at the level of enforcement taken when enforcing this order.

**Posting:**

Current posting will be modified to reflect the new prohibition. Posting will be completed by the Forest Staff and will be posted at a minimum on both sides of Forest Road 32 washed out portion.

FOREST ROAD 32 CLOSURE

**ORDER NO. T2013-0614-WW-01**

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order within the Umatilla National Forest, until further notice.

- (1.) It is prohibited to operate a motor vehicle on the section of Forest Rd 3200 between junctions of Forest Roads 3200 and 3200020 (Corporation Trailhead) and junctions Forest Roads 3200 and 3200030 (North Fork Umatilla Trailhead).  
**36 CFR 261.54(a)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1.) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2.) Any Federal, State or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571)
