

Supporting Documentation

Statement of Need:

The Umatilla National Forest is planning a 4,468 acre prescribed fire in the area. The closure is to enhance the safety of the public during helicopter operations and to decrease the probability of any altercations with falling trees and rolling debris along these roadways and trails.

Enforcement Procedures: The temporary regulation will be enforced on an observed basis and by Forest Protection Officers in conjunction with burn personnel. No special procedures are established.

Posting:

Signing will be the responsibility of the forest staff. At a minimum the order along with large road closure signs will be posted at all road and trail points designated on attached maps as stated above in the prescribed fire area and helicopter travel route.



Rim Rock Prescribed Fire Closure Order

UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are temporarily prohibited in the area described in this order within the Umatilla National Forest, from Tuesday April 30, 2013 until further notice.


1. Being on the road. For the purpose of this order, this restriction applies to the National Forest System roads and/or segments listed in Appendix A of this order listed below and attached maps.
36CFR 261.54 (a)
2. Being on the trail. For the purpose of this order, this restriction applies to the National Forest System trails and/or segments listed in Appendix A of this order listed below and attached maps.
36CFR 261.55 (a)

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. An Forest Service Employee when performing official duties

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571)
