ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR **ORDER NUMBER WNF-14-01-2013**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and for the protection of public health and safety and resources, the following act(s) is prohibited within the specified area(s). This order is effective from April 30th, 2013 and effective until September 30, 2018 unless amended or terminated by the Forest Supervisor.

FIRE

- 261.52(a) BUILDING, MAINTAINING, OR ATTENDING A FIRE OUTSIDE OF A FIRE RING ON OR WITHIN 150 FEET OF ANY DESIGNATED TRAIL OR DEVELOPED PARKING AREA.
- 261.52(a) BUILDING, MAINTAINING, OR ATTENDING A FIRE IN OR WITHIN 150 FEET OF ANY OIL/GAS PRODUCTION AND STORAGE EQUIPMENT.
- 261.52(b) USING ANY TYPE OF EXPLOSIVE, WITHOUT WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION OF A FOREST OFFICER.
- 261.52(f) POSSESSING, DISCHARGING OR USING ANY KIND OF FIREWORK OR OTHER PYROTECHNIC DEVICE
- 261.52(j) OPERATING OR USING ANY INTERNAL OR EXTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINE ON NATIONAL FOREST LANDS, WITHOUT A SPARK ARRESTING DEVICE PROPERLY INSTALLED, MAINTAINED AND IN EFFECTIVE WORKING ORDER MEETING EITHER, (1) DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE STANDARD 5100-ia; OR (2) APPROPRIATE SOCIETY OF AUTOMOTIVE ENGINEERS (SAE) RECOMMEND PRACTICE J335(b) AND J35(a).
- 261.52(k) VIOLATE THE STATE OF OHIO OPEN BURNING REGULATIONS

SPECIAL CLOSURES

- 261.53(e) OPERATING OR USING A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT EMITS A NOISE IN EXCESS OF: NINETY-NINE (99) DECIBELS AT TWENTY (20) INCHES FROM THE EXHAUST OUTLET IN ACCORDANCE WITH SAE J1287, JUNE 1980.
- 261.53(e) OPERATING OR RIDING AN OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLE (ATV, UTV, OFF HIGHWAY MOTORCYCLE, AND DUAL SPORT MOTORCYCLE) WHILE CARRYING PASSENGERS IN EXCESS OF THE MANUFACTURERS RECOMMENDATION.
- 261.53(e) OPERATING OR RIDING AN OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLE (ATV, UTV, OFF HIGHWAY MOTORCYCLE, AND DUAL SPORT MOTORCYCLE) WITHOUT EYE PROTECTION AND A HELMET THAT MEETS UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SAFETY STANDARDS.
- 261.53(e) POSSESS A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE UNLESS SUCH SUBSTANCE WAS OBTAINED BY THE POSSESSOR DIRECTLY, OR PURSUANT TO A VALID PRESCRIPTION OR ORDER, FROM A PRACTITIONER ACTING IN THE COURSE OF PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE OR OTHERWISE ALLOWED BY FEDERAL OR STATE LAW
- CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE MEANS A DRUG OR OTHER SUBSTANCE, OR IMMEDIATE PRECURSOR, INCLUDED IN SCHEDULES I, II, III, IV, V OF PART B OF THE CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT (21 U.S.C. § 812)
- OR A DRUG OR SUBSTANCE ADDED TO THESE SCHEDULES PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF THE ACT.
- 261.53(e) POSSESS A DEVICE CAPABLE OF ASSISTING INGESTION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE INTO THE HUMAN BODY BY ANY OF THE FOLLOWING METHODS: SMOKING, INHALING, SNORTING, INJECTING, SWALLOWING, DISSOLVING, APPLYING, OR OTHERWISE DIRECTING THE CONSUMPTION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE.
- 261.53(e) BE ON LANDS OWNED OR ADMINISTERED BY THE NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM WHILE INTOXICATED TO A DEGREE THAT HE OR SHE MAY BE A DANGER TO HIM/HERSELF OR OTHERS OR DAMAGE PROPERTY OR FOREST RESOURCES.

261.53(f) POSSESSING OR OPERATING A MOTORIZED VEHICLE UPON ANY UTILITY RIGHT-OF-WAY, EXCEPT WITH WRITTEN PERMISSION.

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS

261.54(c) USING A NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROAD FOR COMMERCIAL HAULING WITHOUT A PERMIT.

261.54(d) OPERATING ON A NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROAD ANY MOTOR VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF OHIO STATE TRAFFIC CODE.

261.54(e) OPERATING OR POSSESSING A MOTORIZED VEHICLE ON NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROAD THAT IS CLOSED TO TRAFFIC BY MEANS OF A GATE, SIGN, OR OTHERWISE BLOCKED BY MOUND OF DIRT OR OTHER PHYSICAL MEANS.

261.54(f) OPERATING A VEHICLE CARELESSLY, RECKLESSLY, OR WITHOUT REGARD FOR THE RIGHTS OR SAFETY OF OTHER PERSONS OR IN A MANNER OR AT A SPEED THAT WOULD ENDANGER OR BE LIKELY TO ENDANGER ANY PERSON OR PROPERTY.

FOREST DEVELOPMENT TRAILS

261.55(c) POSSESSING OR USING A MOTORIZED VEHICLE, BICYCLE, SADDLE, PACK, OR DRAFT ANIMAL ON ANY TRAIL NOT DESIGNATED FOR THAT USE.

261.55(e) SHORTCUTTING A SWITCHBACK ON ANY DESIGNATED TRAIL.

261.56 POSSESSING OR USING A MOTOR VEHICLE OFF NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS EXCEPT ON DESIGNATED OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLE TRAILS. OPERATORS OF OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLE (ATV, UTV, OFF HIGHWAY MOTORCYCLE, AND DUAL SPORT MOTORCYCLE) SHALL BE IN POSSESSION OF A VALID STATE DRIVERS LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD (IF APPLICABLE).

OCCUPANCY AND USE

- 261.58(a) CAMPING OR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CAMPSITE WITHIN THE WAYNE NATIONAL FOREST SHALL BE LIMITED TO A PERIOD OF TIME NOT TO EXCEED 14 DAYS IN ANY 30 DAY TIME PERIOD.
- 261.58(b) ENTERING OR USING A DEVELOPED RECREATION SITE OR PORTION THEREOF WHEN POSTED CLOSED.
- 261.58(e) WHILE CAMPING, IT IS PROHIBITED TO OPERATE AN ELECTRICAL GENERATOR BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10:00 P.M. AND 6:00 A.M., EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED AREAS.
- 261.58(f) OCCUPYING AN INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPED CAMPSITE WITH MORE THAN 8 PERSONS AND 3 CAMPING UNITS (1 RV AND 2 TENTS).
- 261.58(g) PARKING OR LEAVING A VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF POSTED INSTRUCTIONS.
- 261.58(h) PARKING OR LEAVING A VEHICLE OUTSIDE A PARKING SPACE ASSIGNED TO ONE'S OWN CAMP UNIT.
- 261.58(i) POSSESSING, PARKING, OR LEAVING MORE THAN TWO VEHICLES, EXCEPT MOTORCYCLES OR BICYCLES, PER CAMP UNIT.
- 261.58(j) BEING PUBLICLY NUDE.
- 261.58(k) SWIMMING OR BEING IN THE WATER WITHIN 100 FEET OF A DESIGNATED BOAT RAMP, UNLESS LOADING OR UNLOADING A BOAT.
- 261.58(k) SWIMMING OR BEING IN A DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREA IS PERMITTED DURING DAY LIGHT HOURS ONLY.
- 261.58(k) POSSESSION OF A GLASS DRINK CONTAINER IN A DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREA.

- 261.58(m) DISCHARGING A FIREARM, AIR RIFLE, OR GAS GUN FROM, INTO, OR ACROSS ANY PARKING AREA, TRAIL, BOAT RAMP OR NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROAD.
- 261.58(n) POSSESSING OR OPERATING A BOAT WITHIN A DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREA.
- 261.58(n) OPERATING A GAS POWERED MOTORBOAT ON THE FOLLOWING LAKES; TIMBRE RIDGE AND VESUVIUS.
- 261.58(n) POSSESSION OR OPERATION OF A BOAT, MOTORBOAT, PERSONAL WATERCRAFT IN VIOLATION OF FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL LAWS.
- 261.58(p) STORING OR LEAVING A BOAT OR RAFT ON NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS.
- 261.58(q) OPERATING ANY WATERCRAFT IN EXCESS OF A POSTED SPEED LIMIT.
- 261.58(t) POSSESSING, STORING, OR TRANSPORTING ANY PART OF A TREE OR OTHER PLANT IN VIOLATION OF EXISTING STATE OR FEDERAL LAW.
- 261.58(u) BEING IN A DEVELOPED CAMPGROUND AREA BETWEEN 10:00 P.M. AND 6:00 A.M. UNLESS A PERSON IS CAMPING.
- 261.58(v) FISHING IN DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREA.
- 261.58(v) HUNTING OVER BAITED AREAS IN VIOLATION OF STATE LAW. HOWEVER, THIS PROHIBITION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE USE OF TRAPS OR SNARES FOR THE TAKING OF FUR-BEARING AND PREDATORY ANIMALS IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE FEDERAL AND STATE LAWS.
- 261.58(aa) RIDING, HITCHING, TETHERING OR HOBBLING A HORSE OR OTHER SADDLE ANIMAL, PACK ANIMAL, OR LIVESTOCK ON OR WITHIN A DEVELOPED RECREATION AREA UNLESS POSTED OPEN.
- 261.58(bb) POSSESSION, CONSUMPTION, OR DISTRIBUTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE IN VIOLATION OF STATE LAW OR PROVIDING AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE TO A PERSON WHO IS LESS THAN 21 YEARS OF AGE.


261.58(bb) POSSESSING AN OPEN CONTAINER AND OR CONSUMPTION OF A BEVERAGE WHICH IS DEFINED AS AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE BY STATE LAW, IS PROHIBITED IN BOAT RAMPS, OHV TRAILS, OHV TRAILHEADS, AND SWIMMING BEACHES.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
