The management direction shown on this map and defined in the Revised Land and Resource Management Plan or FEIS applies to National Forest System Lands only. The direction does not apply to private, state, or other ownerships (shown in white). The legal and administrative boundaries shown on this map are approximate. The location of land ownerships or legal designations are the best available at this time. Accurate landline locations are determined prior to implementation of projects. Any discrepancies between this map and the map printed with the Forest Plan in 1997 are due to Forest Plan amendments.
