FOREST ORDER

Entering or being in the area until resource damage is rehabilitated.

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR Part 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited within the boundaries of the Umpqua National Forest as shown in Exhibit A – Area Map, due to resource damage in the South Umpqua Falls campground area. The order is effective beginning April 18, 2013 and ending on May 17th, 2013, unless rescinded sooner.

- 1) Entering or using a developed recreation site or portion thereof. **[36 CFR 261.58(b)]**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, State, or local Officer of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 2) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


