



**ORDER
STAGE I FIRE RESTRICTIONS
Cibola National Forest and Grasslands
Mt. Taylor Ranger District**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Mt Taylor Ranger District of the Cibola National Forest and Grasslands, in the counties of Cibola, McKinley, and Sandoval, within the state of New Mexico. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, charcoal, coal, or wood stove, except within a Forest Service developed recreation site or Forest Service improved site; 36 CFR § 261.52(a). The use of petroleum-fueled stoves, lanterns or heating devices are allowed provided such devices meet the fire underwriter's specifications for safety.
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable material; 36 CFR § 261.52(d).

EXEMPTIONS:


Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any federal, state or local officer or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Residents, owners and lessees of land, and holders of Forest Service recreation special use authorizations, within the restricted area are exempt from Restriction No. 1 above ONLY, provided such fires are within a permanent structure.

This Order is necessary to protect public health and safety due to the increased fire danger.

This Order becomes effective at 8:00 AM, on May 10, 2013, and will remain in force until rescinded or until December 31, 2013.
