



**WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST
ORDER # 18-2013-01-02**

EMERGENCY CLOSURE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on roads described in this order within the Willamette National Forest. This order will become effective at 1pm on May 13, 2013, and will remain in effect until May 15, 2013 at 5am.

- (1) Being on a road closed for public health and safety.
§36 CFR 261.54(e)**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR §261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.**
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local official or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.**
- (3) Persons engaged in a business in the area. Specifically, contractors Weekly Brothers INC and Eugene Sand and Gravel.**

DESCRIPTION OF THE AFFECTED AREA:

Forest Road 15 between the south end boat launch and the Lookout Campground. The total distance of this closure is approximately 2.7 miles. (See attached map, Exhibit A).
