


Jake Timber Sale

Notes

All landlines are approximate.

All designated survey monument bearing trees shall have a maximum stump height of not less than 6 inches above the official inscription or poster, BT6.23.

Equipment needs to be free of soil, vegetative material, seeds and other debris that could hold seeds, BT6.35.

Purchaser shall subsoil all new temporary roads, and landings not located on forest system roads to a depth of 20 inches, CT5.1# (Option 1), CT6.6#.

Restricted November 1st through April 30 for snowmobile route, CT5.12#.

Covering of all Landing and Unit slash piles required, CT6.74#.
