Timp Trails Summary – July 9, 2018

Aspen Grove: Small amounts of snow are still present on the trail above Emerald Lake toward the Saddle. Lower sections have melted out. Snow is still present in small amounts off the trail. Streams still can be dangerous and fast moving. **Hikers should continue to be very cautious as conditions continue to change daily.**

Timpooneke: Snow is present in very small amounts as you approach the “Saddle” toward the top. Streams still can be dangerous and fast moving. Snow can still be present in small amounts off the trail. **Hikers should continue to be very cautious as conditions continue to change daily.**

Scout Falls is dry except for a small stream to the east of the main falls (you can see it through the trees at the overlook). The hike up is still very pleasant.

The parking lots at both trail heads are now filling up early Saturday morning... Water sources will continue to dry up along the trail as the summer continues... The snowfield (Glacier) has already mostly melted. Rocks are very prevalent due to the low snow amounts. We never recommend sliding down the Glacier but this year will be particularly dangerous.

The weather might be the biggest issue this week. Hot, dry, windy, with a chance of extreme thunderstorms. It can still be very cool and windy toward the top of Timpanogos. Recommendations for all hikers include proper equipment (good boots), experience traveling over snow, water, sunscreen, food, jacket and a garbage bag.
