(STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, Colo.) May 14, 2013 – In celebration of International Migratory Bird Day, the Medicine Bow-Routt National Forests and Thunder Basin National Grassland will be co-hosting a Family Activity Fair on Sunday, May 19 in Steamboat Springs, Colo.
