Tuesday, June 4th, 2013 – Meet at Lake Glendale

9:00 a.m. - Noon

Directions: Between Harrisburg and Metropolis, turn off of 145 to Lake Glendale Recreation area to Goose Bay Picnic area.

Wednesday, June 5th, 2013 – Meet at Cedar Lake

9:00 a.m. - Noon

Directions: Off Route 127, take Boat Dock Road to Cedar Lake boat ramp area.
