

Order No. 06-13-02
Lassen National Forest
Panther Fire Emergency Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Almanor Ranger District of the Lassen National Forest. This Order is effective from 2 p.m. on May 15, 2013, until the Panther Fire has been fully suppressed.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Panther Fire Closure Area, as shown on Exhibit A and described in Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.53(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Panther Fire Closure Area. 36 CFR 261.54(e).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the Panther Fire Closure Area to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.
4. Persons who reside on private land in the Panther Fire Closure Area to the extent necessary to gain access to their residences.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions found in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.

The boundary of the Panther Fire Closure Area begins at the southwest corner of Section 36 (Township 27 North, Range 2 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian), then continues north along the section line to the northwest corner of the same section, then continues west along the section line to the southwest corner of Section 26, then continues north along the section line to the northwest corner of the same section, then continues east along the section line to the northeast corner of the same section, then continues north along the section line to the northwest corner of Section 24, then continues east along the section line to the northeast corner of the same section, then continues south along the section line to its intersection with Forest Road No. 28N29, then continues south along Forest Road No. 28N29 to its intersection with the section line on the west side of Section 20 (Township 27 North, Range 3 East), then continues north along the section line to the northwest corner of the same section, then continues east along the section line to the northeast corner of the same section, then continues north along the section line to the northwest corner of Section 16, then continues east along the section line to the northeast corner of Section 14, then continues south along the section line to the southeast corner of Section 26, then continues west along the section line to the southwest corner of the same section, then continues south along the section line to the southeast corner of Section 34, then continues west along the section line back to the starting point.




Exhibit A
