

National Trails Day, June 1st 2013

General Information:

Project Start Time: 8:30

Project End Time: early afternoon

What to Bring: Snacks, lunch, water, work gloves, sunscreen etc.

What to Wear: Long pants/jeans, work shoes (no open toed shoes), short sleeve shirt, other layers as needed for the forecasted weather

Parking: Due to limited parking, participants are encouraged to carpool to the worksites

Recreation Fee Pass: There is no fee to drive up and park while you're volunteering on National Trails Day. If you're going to stay on afterwards and recreate at any of the fee sites, you'll need to pay the entrance fee. As you pull through the information booth, stop and let them know that you're a volunteer working on the National Trails Day project and they will let you through.

South Fork Little Deer Creek Trail #252 Work Project

- **Project Description:** This project is aimed at completing the finishing details, improving drainage and tread work, and installing several signs along the new reroute. New trails require several years of this type of follow up maintenance as the tread settles and the hardened use patterns develop.
- **Location:** Take SR-92 to Forest Road #114 (Cascade Springs Scenic Drive). Follow this road approximately 1.5 miles, there will be a large dispersed campsite area/trailhead known as Elk Camp on the right side of the road.



Timpooneke Trail #053 Work Project

- **Project Description:** This project is aimed at completing finishing details around the new Timpooneke Trailhead including seeding, moving rock, installing erosion cloth, staining kiosks, working on the trail alignments leaving the trailhead and general maintenance work on the Timpooneke Trail.
- **Location:** Take SR-92 to the junction with the Timpooneke Road #056. Take the Timpooneke Road past the campground. Shortly after turn in to the Timpooneke Trailhead on the left side of the road
