

FOREST ORDER

**USDA FOREST SERVICE
PIKE NATIONAL FOREST
Pikes Peak Ranger District**

**Occupancy and Use Restrictions
Waldo Canyon Fire Area**

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Waldo Canyon Fire Area on the Pike National Forest, El Paso County, Colorado, (the "Restricted Area") and on all roads and trails located within the Restricted Area (the "Restricted Roads and Trails"). The Restricted Area and the Restricted Roads and Trails are depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A.

The purpose of this Order is to protect natural resources and public safety due to the impacts of the wildland fire.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Going into or being upon the Restricted Area. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e) and 36 C.F.R. § 261.52(e)
2. Being on the Restricted Roads. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e),
3. Being on the Restricted Trails. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a),
4. Being on Rampart Range Road (NFSR 300) between the Restricted Area and the southern terminus of the road in Garden of the Gods Park. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e) .

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any federal, state or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force, in the performance of an official duty;
2. Employees, contractors, or subcontractors of Colorado Springs Utilities in the performance of authorized work within the Restricted Area;
3. Employees, contractors, subcontractors, volunteers or clients of Eagle Lake Camp who are travelling to and from Eagle Lake Camp through the Restricted Area by motor vehicle on Rampart Range Road (NFSR 300);
4. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This Order supersedes, rescinds and replaces Order 12-20, issued October 2, 2012.

This Order shall remain in effect for one year from the date signed, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.
