Colorado Recreation Resource Advisory Committee will meet in Glenwood Springs

Golden, CO (May 28, 2013)-- The Colorado Recreation Resource Advisory Committee (RRAC) will meet at the Glenwood Suites, 2625 Gilstrap Court, Glenwood Springs, CO in the Meeting Room, June 5, 2013. The RRAC will focus on proposals for new cabin rental fees for Fitton and Off Cow Camp cabins on the Rio Grande National Forest. There will also be an update on fee status for Maroon Valley on the White River National Forest. The discussion is limited to Forest Service staff and Committee members. Persons who wish to bring recreation fee matters to the attention of the RRAC may file written statements with the Committee staff before or after the meeting. There will be a public input session at the beginning of the meeting and individuals who made written requests by June 1, 2013 will have the opportunity to address the Committee at the meeting.

The Recreation RAC is authorized under the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act, signed into law December 2004.
