Horse Restriction


Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts or omissions are prohibitions hereinafter set forth apply to the Paint Creek Road, Forest System Road #41, Unaka Ranger District, within the Cherokee National Forest, shown on the attached map.

1. Use of a horse trailer. 36 CFR 261.54 a
2. Riding, hitching, tethering, or hobbling a horse or other saddle or pack animal in violation of posted instructions within the designated area on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays from May 15 through September 15 for each calendar year. 36 CFR 261.58aa

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons or areas are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission, issued by the District Ranger.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of these prohibitions set forth above is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. See 16 U.S.C. 551, 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.
